- The program is designed to be respectful of the topic and your time. It takes about one hour to complete and is accessible anytime on computers with internet connection.

- No Minors Please. The Safe & Sacred Website contains material that is appropriate for adults only. "Circle of Grace" is a special training program for our young people.

- All new personnel are subject to a criminal background check. After signing up you will either
 be redirected to Screening One to complete an online background check or be asked to have
 a fingerprint background check completed this depends on which ministry you will be
 involved in. All school employees and volunteer coaches must do a fingerprint background
 check; everyone else receives a simple background check through Screening One. Please
 click on the question mark next to "I am a..." under "My Ministry" to learn more about what
 ministry you belong to.
- Complete the first lesson in a new 4-cycle of training lessons, 1. Recognizing Child Abuse. Be sure to read and follow the instructions through all of the steps.
- Your certificate of completion will be issued as soon as your criminal background check has been completed and approved.
