PAULINE PRIVILEGE: The dissolution of a marriage between two unbaptized parties, *one of who is later baptized*, provided the non-baptized party departs (cc1143-1147)

- It is pastorally important that the Petitioner understand this process. It should be made clear that this is an attempt to **dissolve** a previous marriage, not to declare in null or invalid. Hence, the validity of the previous bond is not challenged. Under no circumstances should the Petitioner be made to feel uncomfortable because of non-baptism.
