

# DIOCESAN RECOVERY UPDATE No. 2

The second anniversary of Hurricane Laura is fast approaching this August 27<sup>th</sup>, 2022. A category 4 storm with sustained winds in excess of 150 miles per hour and 9 feet of storm surge, Hurricane Laura wreaked havoc on Southwest Louisiana and over 500 structures in the Diocese of Lake Charles. Many of these were further damaged only six weeks later by Hurricane Delta, followed by the winter ice storm of February 2021 and historic flooding in May of the same year.

This is the second in a series of monthly snapshots highlighting the ongoing recovery of the Diocese of Lake Charles. These statistics help illustrate where we are in the ongoing repair and rebuilding process, estimated to cost \$135-\$150 million dollars.

We are grateful for our architects who are heading up these significant repairs and rebuilds, and for the understanding and cooperation of our diocesan pastors, parishioners, and staff as we continue to work with FEMA to recoup the majority of these staggering costs.
