FAVOR OF THE FAITH PETITION INSTRUCTIONS AND FORMS

Preliminary questions about the merit of the case should be asked by the priest who is helping the couple with this process. Once all the preliminary documents are submitted to the Tribunal, the case will be instructed in Lake Charles and then it will be referred to the Holy See for resolution.

FORMS AND DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR A FAVOR OF THE FAITH PETITION

Petitioner:

- Fact Sheet
- Initial Interview Form to be completed with Parish Priest
- Marriage License for each marriage; Originals will be returned.
- Marriage Certificate for each marriage; Originals will be returned.
- Divorce Decree (*final*) for each marriage
- If Jewish, the Final Divorce Decree and the "get"
- Certificate of Death of spouse if applicable to any marriage
- Affidavit of non-baptism and questionnaires from at least 2 witnesses of each non-baptized party (Petitioner, Other Party, or both)
 - N.B. (The non-baptized person and his/her witnesses will be cited to come to the Tribunal and give testimony once. Arrangements will be made when the case is accepted.)
- Baptismal certificate for children of all marriages, if applicable
- Expense Form signed by Petitioner
- If Petitioner is baptized or is in RCIA, letter of recommendation from parish priest and baptismal certificate.
- If there ever was a civil/criminal conviction or problem, records and documentation are to be included in the case.
- If there ever was a psychological/psychiatric problem, treatment, diagnosis, hospitalization, etc., medical records are to be included.
- Marriage certificate of present marriage of Petitioner and Catholic Party, if applicable

Other Party (first spouse of Petitioner):

- Complete name and present address of this party must be given by the Petitioner
- If this person is the non-baptized party, the proofs of non-baptism fall on him/her, and therefore the two witnesses must be on his/her side (family, relatives). Arrangements for their testimonies will be made.

Catholic Party or Prospective Spouse:

- Baptismal Certificate (recently issued, with notations on back)
- Baptismal Certificate for children of all marriages, if applicable
- Marriage License for each marriage (long form of marriage certificate) if applicable
- Marriage Certificate for each marriage, if applicable. All originals will be returned.
- Divorce decree
- Annulment decree and sentence, if applicable
- Certificate of Death of Spouse, if applicable
- Letter of recommendation from parish priest

If a civil marriage has been attempted and/or if there are baptized children of the union of Petitioner/Catholic-Prospective Spouse, please include the original certificates of marriage/baptism.

If you have any question as to whether or not the particular case qualifies as a *Favor of the Faith* case, please contact the Tribunal. When the completed documentation is received, the case will receive a protocol number and will be assigned to an Instructor who will cite the parties and their witnesses, and will prepare the case to be submitted to the Holy Father for final decision.

LETTER FROM PASTOR ON BEHALF OF THE CATHOLIC PARTY

A priest assists the processing of the *Favor of the Faith* case by writing a letter of recommendation on behalf of the **Catholic Party**. He is to indicate

- 1) Whether or not the Catholic Party is known to him (how long, etc.).
- 2) Whether or not he/she practices the Catholic faith.
- 3) What is his impression of his/her honesty and truthfulness?
- 4) If this dissolution were granted, would it be a cause of scandal or wonderment in the community?
- 5) Would he recommend the granting of this dispensation in order that the Catholic Party be married in the Catholic Church?

Any additional information would be greatly appreciated.

* If the Petitioner is in the RCIA program, the parish priest can also give a letter of recommendation on his/her behalf.
